Nursery Ministry

6 weeks - 3 years | 9am and 10:30am

CHECK-IN

- Check in at the CheckIn Counter for a nametag and security ticket

WHAT TO BRING

- To make Sunday mornings easier for you, leave your big diaper bag at home. Instead, keep 2 diapers in the bin for your child, located at the Nursery Suite entrance.
- If your child has a favorite soother (stuffy, lovey, pacifier, teether) feel free to send it. If it helps your little one feel comforted and more likely to settle, we welcome it!
- For the health and safety of all children, we ask that you refrain from sending sip cups and water bottles. Babies requiring bottles are an exception.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- If your child is apprehensive at drop off, rest assured our caregivers are prepared to settle them! If your child is still unsettled after 15 minutes, someone will notify you to return to the Nursery. If you do not hear from us, then all is well!
- Nursery Caregivers are ready to comfort your child while you serve, attend service or group; playing, singing, reading and rocking. It's ok to leave them with your fussy baby!
- Toddlers will engage in age-appropriate play while babies are held and rocked. All will hear a Bible story each Sunday.
- If potty training, use a potty sticker to help caregivers to remind. The Nursery Suite is equipped with a tiny potty.

PICK-UP

- After service, stop at the CheckIn Counter to be scanned out before heading to the Nursery Suite.

CAREGIVERS

- All volunteers serving in all areas of Children's Ministry are required to submit PA clearances.

Preschool Ministry

3 years - 5 years | 9am and 10:30am

CHECK-IN

- Check in at the CheckIn Counter for a nametag and security ticket

WHAT TO BRING

- Nothing! Once your child is 3 and potty-trained, it is not necessary to provide any supplies
- At this stage many Preschoolers have a favorite toy, but we encourage you to leave them at home. This prevents favorites from getting misplaced, lost or forgotten!
- For the health and safety of all children, we ask that you refrain from sending sip cups and water bottles.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- If your child is apprehensive at drop off, rest assured our leaders are prepared to settle them! If your child is still unsettled after 15 minutes, someone will notify you to return to the classroom. If you do not hear from us, then all is well!
- Preschoolers join the very beginning of Kids Worship for Praise and Worship Time and then head to their classroom.
- After music, Connect Group time in their classroom includes free play, then lesson time which includes activities, games and crafts.
- The Preschool room is equipped with a tiny potty. If your child is newly potty-trained and still susceptible to accidents, use a potty sticker to help teachers to give reminder throughout the morning.

PICK-UP

- After service, stop at the CheckIn Counter to be scanned out before heading to your child's classroom.
